Scavenge Camp	A makeshift enemy camp set up near the wreckage to loot the payload.	Works as a primary spawning or objective point, abundant with tactical choke points.

The CS: GO crash site is rarely utilized for standard Premier or Competitive matches. Rather, its special geometry shines in alternative video game modes developed to evaluate various ability.

4. Prevent Clustered Pushes:

- Because the cargo hold funnels players into tight areas, pushing as a tight group makes the group susceptible to spam fire and explosive damage. Maintain appropriate spacing.

5. The Evolution: From CS: GO to Counter-Strike 2 (CS2)

With the shift from CS: GO to *Counter-Strike 2*, environments received an enormous technological overhaul thanks to the Source 2 engine. Dynamic lighting, volumetric smoke, and boosted particle effects breathed brand-new life into functional maps and customized environments.
