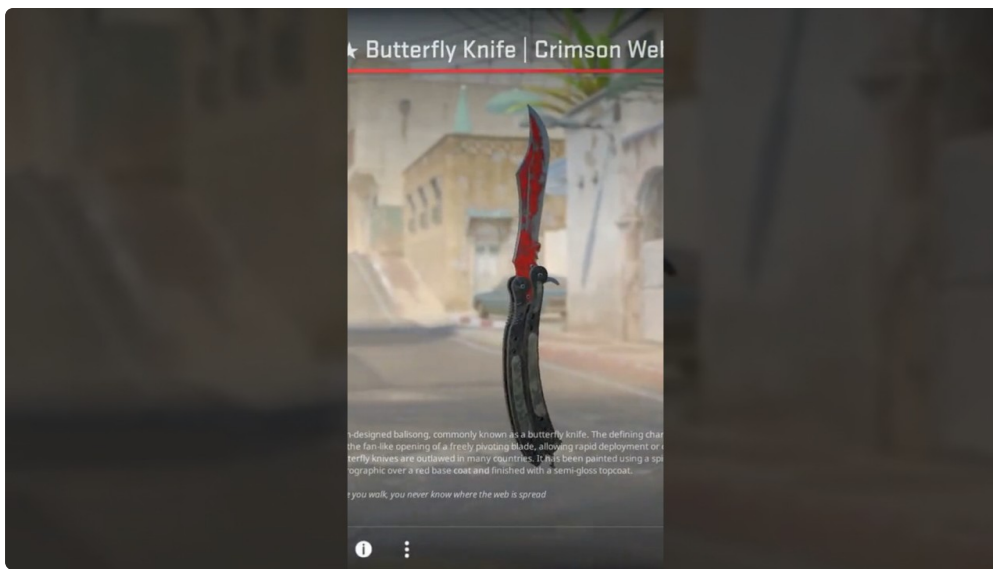
Rates are stemmed from the Steam Community Market and trustworthy third-party markets since early 2025. They change in reaction to case appeal, operation cycles, and overall need.
