Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the primary wheel, a smaller sized two-reel slot machine located straight above the wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins simultaneously.

The puck bounces down randomly up until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, each consisting of a multiplier. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 section on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a lively, surreal virtual world featuring a colossal 64-segment wheel. The host picks one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, allowing multipliers to reach up to an incredible 20,000 x.
