

Garage door repair in Pasadena: What Homeowners Need to Know

A malfunctioning **garage door opener** may produce clicking sounds, stop midway, fail to respond to the remote control, or operate inconsistently. Causes include worn gears, a defective circuit board, misaligned sensors, power interruptions, or a damaged drive belt or chain. Opener repair may resolve the problem, although an older unit without current safety features may be a less suitable choice for continued service.

Other frequent issues include cable replacement, track alignment, roller replacement, loose hinges, worn bearings, and a damaged bottom seal.
