

A cracked windshield is not cosmetic. It is not "just glass." On a modern vehicle, the windshield is tied to visibility, crash performance, adhesive chemistry, camera alignment, and driver-assistance systems that may depend on a clean, correctly positioned view through the glass. The windshield supports driving visibility every mile the vehicle moves. It also has a role in crash safety because the bond between the glass and the vehicle body must hold under force. An installer can remove the old glass and set the new one in place, but until the adhesive reaches the required safe drive-away condition, the vehicle may not be ready to drive.

Even slight changes matter because the system depends on alignment.

ADAS windshield calibration is the process of recalibrating those systems after glass work when required by the vehicle manufacturer. The Auto Glass Safety Council treats proper calibration after auto glass replacement as integral to vehicle safety, and its standards call for calibration equipment specifically designed for the manufacturer-required recalibration process. That is a strong signal to drivers: calibration is not an upsell when the vehicle calls for it. It is part of doing the job correctly.

Some manufacturers make this point clearly. GM has stated that a service-point calibration or learn is critical whenever a front-view windshield camera is involved. Kia service guidance referenced by federal safety materials indicates that windshield damage or replacement can trigger ADAS-related procedures, including lane departure warning system calibration. The details vary by vehicle, but the principle is firm. If the windshield replacement affects a front camera system, the vehicle may need calibration.
