The Mechanics Behind CS2 Casinos

1. The Steam Web API and Bot Trades

CS2 casinos do not link directly to Valve's servers for monetary transactions. Instead, they use the Steam Web API to facilitate peer-to-peer trades or bot-controlled stock transfers. When a player transfers a skin, a trade deal is sent to a designated automated bot account. As soon as accepted, the skin's estimated market price (usually pulled from third-party pricing sites like Buff or Steam) is credited to the gamer's account balance.

2. Provably Fair Systems
