Deadbolt upgrades and smart lock choices

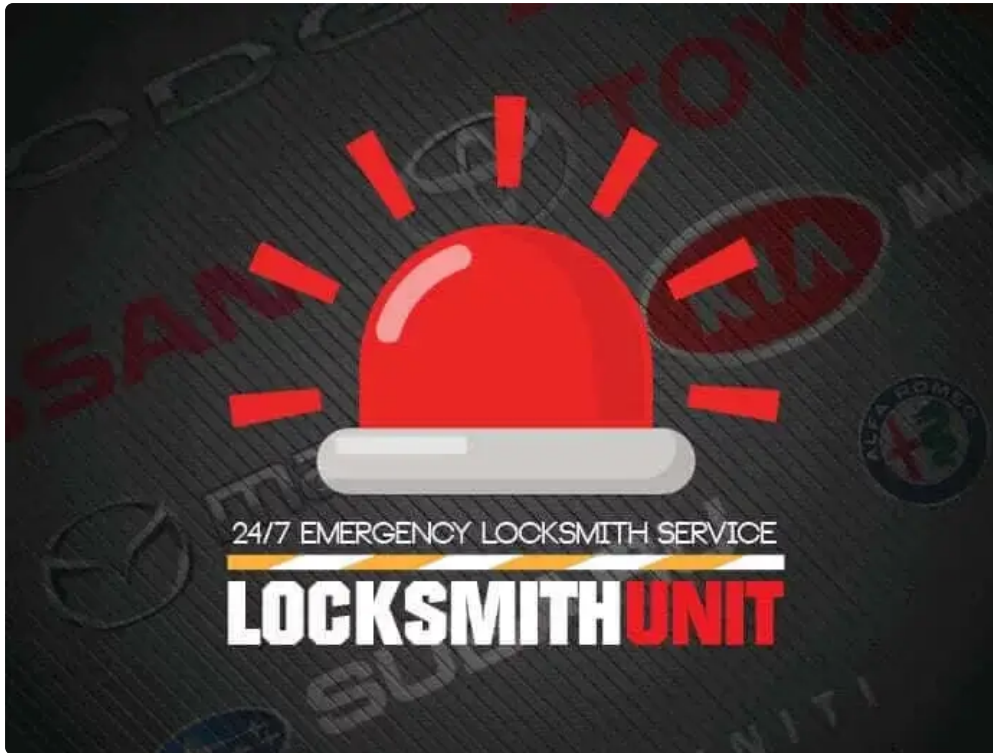
