- **How it works:** Utilize the two-bet feature. Set Bet 1 to cash out early (e.g., at 2.0 x) to secure a guaranteed return covering both stakes, and let Bet 2 run longer to chase after a high multiplier.
- **Objective:** Mitigate risk while keeping the door open for enormous payouts.

3. The High-Risk, High-Reward Chaser

- **How it works:** Wait out several rounds and aim for multipliers exceeding 10x, 20x, or more.
