A traditional 1v1 game of possibility. Two gamers wager skins of roughly equal value. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to alternative. Users wager on expert groups using chances determined by the platform, comparable to conventional sportsbooks.
