Salt air deposits chlorides that corrode fasteners and might etch some finishes. Wind moves grit that abrades polished surfaces. Granite: the secure general, with caveats

In so much climates, properly-chosen granite stays my first advice for backyard kitchens. The key phrase is neatly-chosen. Granite is a loose umbrella term. Some slabs sold as “granite” are technically gneiss or schist, with mica-rich planes that flake beneath UV and temperature cycling. Others are dense, low-porosity, and virtually bulletproof.

Downsides are ordinary. Some lighter granites improve rust spots open air if they contain iron. Black granites in full sun get uncomfortably scorching to touch and can trigger burn chance. The tops have lightened a touch in complete solar however have not stained or cracked. The lesson: dense granite, honed finish, simple protection, and genuine reinforce make for a quiet lifestyles.

In Phoenix, a porcelain-clad island with a Calacatta appearance sits in a courtyard that sees nearly 300 sunny days per yr. We used 12-millimeter panels with mitered corners and aluminum honeycomb support. The patron chefs countless nights per week. After three summers, no yellowing, no stains, and the merely mark is a small chip in which a heavy bottle hit an part. We stuffed it with a coloration-matched kit. The lesson: porcelain's UV resistance will pay off below relentless sun.

A concrete peninsula in the Midwest, solid with an indispensable drain board and a 2.5-inch the front facet, appeared perfect at handoff. Two winters later, a topical sealer flaked in a prime-visitors nook and water found out its method into microcracks. The client generally known as us prior to it unfold. We stripped and switched to a penetrating technique with wax true-ups. It is steady now, but it calls for a renovation recurring and respectable verbal exchange. The lesson: outside sealers will have to be chosen for UV and freeze-thaw, and clientele will have to be ready for periodic care.
