

A fencing looks easy from the footpath. A line of posts, some rails, a little bit of mesh or hardwood, and unexpectedly the border really feels defined. However on the ground, the genuine job is hidden a couple of spade-widths down. If the blog post openings are wrong, the fence won't fail in a dramatic way initially. It will certainly lean a little after wintertime, droop after a gusty week, then begin to rattle whenever a vehicle passes. Why fencing stamina begins at the post hole

Most fencing failings are not concerning the lumber boards or the colorbond panels. They have to do with the anchor. A message opening is generally a soil pocket wrapped around a structural member. When wind loads push the fencing sideways, the post withstands by:

- resisting turning (it can't twist out of the ground)
- resisting pull-out (it can not lift as the dirt loosens up)
- resisting flexing (it has enough depth and embedment to maintain the lots consistent)

- posts that gradually lean as the soil settles around them
- panels that start to rack at the top line (the fence appears like a soft joint now, not a stiff border)

- fence darkness shifting after a wet run, due to the fact that the ground releases a little, then re-locks after drying

A pair years back, a house owner informed me their fencing was "great when installed." The posts were sealed, so they assumed the work was solid. Handling water, wet soil, and unpredictable ground
