1. The AWP|Dragon Lore

Maybe the most popular skin in the game, the Dragon Lore features a mythical dragon breathing fire throughout the body of the sniper rifle. Originally dropped exclusively on specific maps like Cobblestone during significant competitions, these keepsake bundles are now exceedingly uncommon. A Factory New Souvenir Dragon Lore signed by super star player Skaddoodle famously sold for over £ 60,000 years ago, and costs have actually only escalated because.

2. The AK-47|Case Hardened (Pattern 661 "Blue Gem")

While a basic Case Hardened AK-47 is relatively inexpensive, the top-tier pattern indices-- particularly Pattern 661-- cover practically the entire top receiver of the weapon in a beautiful, reflective blue. Because the chances of unpacking this exact pattern with a good float value are astronomically low, these products have commanded personal offers surpassing six figures.

3. StatTrak™ M4A4|Groan

The Howl is unique since it holds historic significance. Valve got rid of the original art work due to a copyright infringement claim, making the skin "Contraband." Valve updated the style and stopped it from dropping entirely. Anyone holding a Howl at that time kept it, creating a completely capped supply.



Factors Influencing the Market
