2. Utility Synergy

- **Flashbangs:** Pop-flashes that detonate instantly in the opponent's field of vision, denying them a chance to look away.
- **Molotovs/Incendiaries:** Used to clear tight angles (like "Newell" on Inferno or "Banana") and hold-up opponent presses.
- **Smokes:** Block sniper lanes and isolate bomb sites throughout execution.

3. Map Control and Defaulting

Rather than rushing a site blindly at the start of every round, experienced groups establish map control (defaulting).

- Spreading out across the map forces the CTs to reveal their positioning.
- Gathering info allows the T-side to rotate quickly toward the weakest point of defense.
