Two topcoats of exterior acrylic observed. We resealed the sprinkler heads and extra a dripline near plantings to retailer overspray from returning. Another project interested a mile of board-on-board cedar fencing alongside a windy ridge. The proprietor sought after a darkish espresso tone. We proposed a stable colour stain rather than paint to deal with thermal stream. Spraying into wind is consistently harmful, so we labored sunrise to mid-morning with wind screens in region. We sprayed and lower back-brushed each and every board part to keep picture framing. The coloration held properly using intense summers. At 12 months 3, the south going through sections confirmed a mild flatting of sheen however no peel, exactly as deliberate.

Choosing colorations that age gracefully
