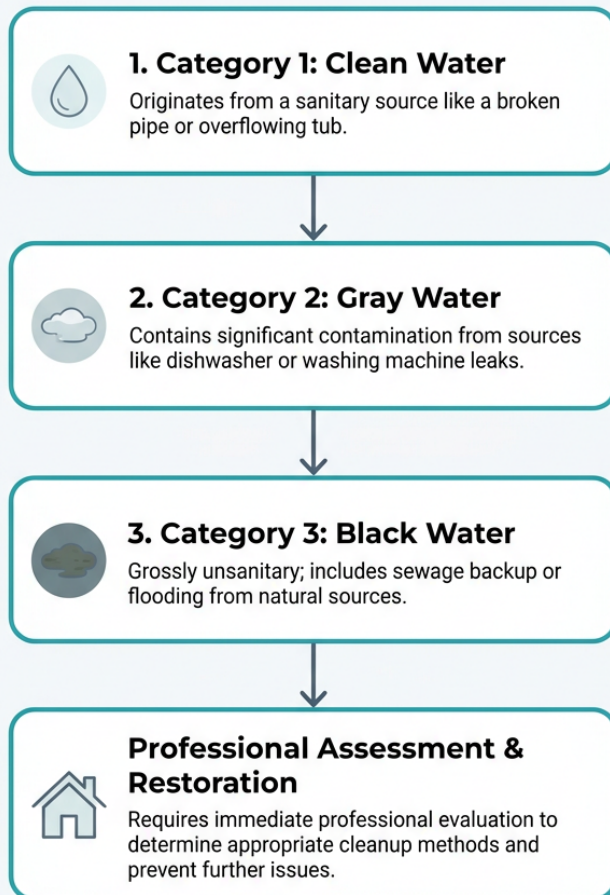

How Does Insurance Calculate Replacement Cost When Salvage Fails?

Insurance adjusters use replacement cost value (RCV) to settle water damage claims, but only if the loss is documented and the item cannot be salvaged. When you delay professional restoration, you inadvertently force your adjuster to apply total-loss settlement to items that could have been saved. A leather sofa that could be professionally restored to near-original condition becomes eligible for full replacement cost—often two to three times what restoration would have cost.
