In 2016, the company provided extensive cease-and-desist letters to dozens of major skin gambling websites, cautioning them that their activities breached the Steam Subscriber Agreement. Throughout the years, Valve has also carried out trade lock limitations (forcing players to wait a week before trading a freshly gotten skin) to suppress rapid-fire wagering.

Regardless of these measures, the industry continues to adapt. Numerous modern CS2 casinos utilize peer-to-peer (P2P) trading systems or cryptocurrency combinations to bypass traditional trade restrictions enforced by Steam, showing resilient in the face of developer crackdowns.
