

If you're planning to drop someone off at the airport and then head straight home, you might be surprised how much those quick kerbside drops can cost — and how quietly airport drop-off fees have been rising in recent years across the UK. Luckily, with a little planning and some smart choices, you can avoid paying expensive charges and still get your passenger to the terminal on time without hassle.

UK Airport Drop-Off Charges: How Much Are You Really Paying?

Across the UK, airports have quietly been increasing the fees charged for kerbside drop offs. The average drop-off charge now stands at around **£6.51**, but this varies significantly depending on where you are.

Airport Average Drop-Off Fee Notes London Heathrow £8.00 One of the most expensive fees; £8 per 10 minutes Manchester £5.50 Mid-range fees apply Glasgow £3.00 Lower fees, but still charged Birmingham £7.00 High fees for the convenience Edinburgh £4.50 Moderate fees with quick access

Though some airports charge modest amounts, the cost of a quick drop at a busy hub like Heathrow or Birmingham can really add up — especially if you're making multiple trips or dropping off several people in the same year.

Free Alternatives: Long Stay Free Windows and Park & Ride Drop Offs

The good news is that if you want to **avoid barrier fee** charges altogether, many airports offer free drop-off options — but they usually require a bit more time, planning, and some willingness to use shuttle buses or walk a little further.

1. Free Park & Ride Drop Off

Many regional airports have free park & ride systems where you can park at a designated lot for free or a very low cost and then take a short shuttle bus directly to the departure terminals. This is often called a "drop-off window" where no charge applies if you leave the car and catch the shuttle instead of lingering at the kerbside.

This means:

- Parking in a free or cheap lot slightly further from the terminal
- Taking a shuttle bus run by the airport or a private company
- A modest extra time allowance for waiting and bus transfer

For drivers heading straight home, this is often the best way to **avoid barrier fee** charges while still getting passengers close to the terminals.

2. Long Stay Free Window

Some airports provide a free "loyalty window" or grace period when dropping off at their Long Stay car parks with shuttle [medium](#) bus transfer. This window might allow 15–30 minutes free parking, perfect for quick drop offs. You'll usually need to register in advance or confirm your stay times to benefit from the free window.



This option is ideal for travellers who don't mind a little extra walk and shuttle time but want to save money.

Trade-Off: Shuttle Bus vs Kerbside Convenience

The core trade-off in choosing the cheapest airport drop-off method comes down to time versus money:

- **Kerbside drop-off:** Fast and convenient but usually comes with a premium fee. You can pull up right at the terminal, drop off, and go. However, expect to pay the airport drop-off charge which is averaging **£6.51** in the UK and rising quietly year on year.
- **Long stay or park & ride options:** Free or very cheap alternatives but involve a shuttle bus ride and extra time. This might mean arriving earlier by 15–30 minutes or more to factor in parking and shuttle transfer times.

Choosing the best option will depend on your priorities — if you want to save money and don't mind some walking or shuttle travel, free park & ride drop off or long-stay free windows are the way to go. If convenience and speed are more important and you're happy to pay the fees, kerbside drop off makes sense.
