Maintenance and seasonal behavior

Wood actions. Painted finishes scuff. Hardware loosens with use. Expect a settling-in length the 1st season after installation. A authentic keep will go back for a song-up after just a few months. The counter sat completely degree, the backsplash tile coursed lightly, and you could not tell the surface sloped unless you rolled a marble. That alternative added an afternoon to the set up and kept years of crooked lines.

In a Victorian with tricky plaster cornices, the buyer wanted full-height cupboards to the ceiling. The cornice various by way of just about an inch across the room. Removing it could have erased a piece of records. We designed a two-component crown on the cupboards, with a small leading cap that could go with the flow and be scribed to the plaster. The eye study one non-stop line, and the plaster remained intact. The excess molding used to be a small price to avoid the house's soul.

Choosing custom for the top reasons
