That's the experience to try to find, not because it's fancy, however since it's predictable.

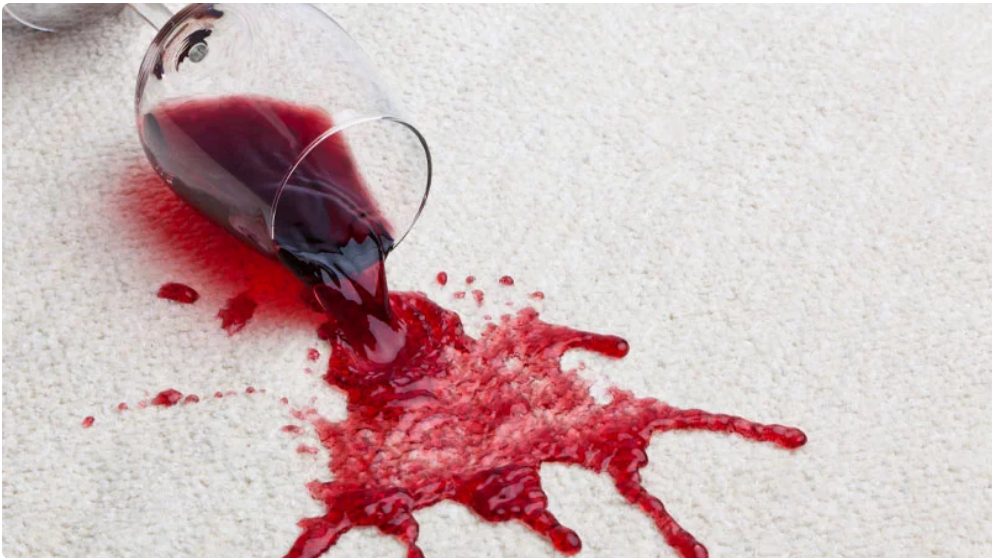
The case for tile and grout proficiency under the same roof
