- Licenses from nations that signed the **1968 Vienna Convention on Road Traffic** can typically be exchanged straight, though tests may be needed depending upon bilateral arrangements and residency duration.
- Licenses from countries under the **1949 Geneva Convention** generally require passing the theoretical state test.
