- **Damaged garage door spring:** The door may become extremely heavy, remain partially raised, or refuse to lift at all.
- **Garage door panel damage:** Dings, splits, rust, and impact damage can affect curb appeal, balance, and weather resistance.
- **Garage door opener failure:** The motor may run without lifting the door, stop responding to controls, or unexpectedly change direction.
- **Damaged tracks:** Warped, loose, or obstructed tracks can make the door stick, scrape, shake, or come off its path.

Do not attempt to remove a spring, lift a heavy door with damaged cables, or force a door back onto its track. Springs and cables are under considerable tension. A professional inspection is safer and can identify whether the cause is a single failed part or a more extensive balance concern.
