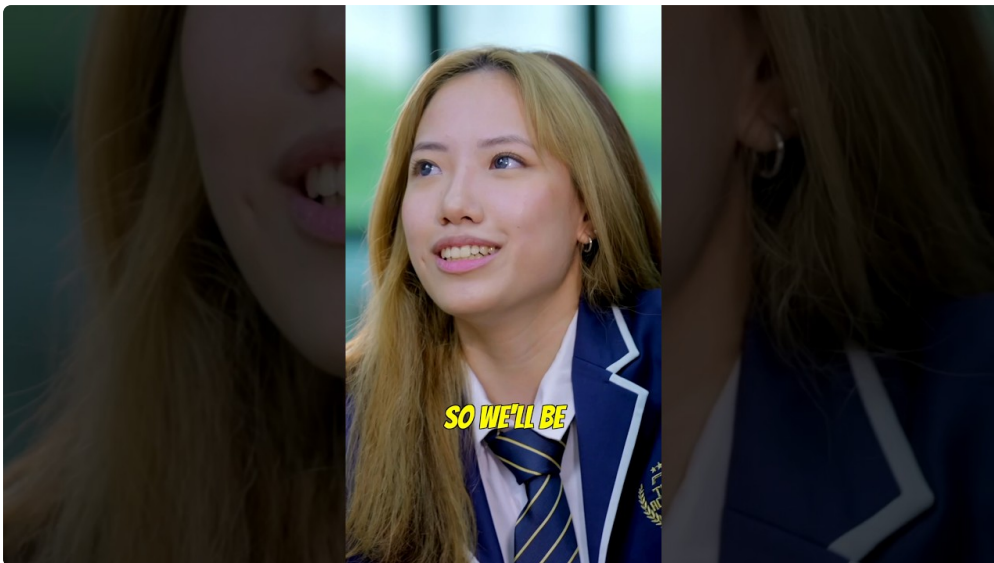


## Making Space for Both
