Advanced players understand that a 6:5 blackjack table is a sucker's bet. They specifically hunt for 3:2 tables, ideally where the dealer bases on a soft 17 (S17) and late surrender is allowed.

2. Card Counting in the Live Environment: Myth vs. Reality

Can you count cards in live dealership blackjack? The brief response is yes, however with considerable caveats.
