

Bow rehair is an essential maintenance procedure for any violin player. A bow that has lost its hair density, or whose hair has become dirty or damaged, cannot produce the tone quality that the instrument is capable of delivering. LVL Music Academy's luthier workshop handles bow rehairs alongside its broader range of instrument maintenance and repair services. Alan Senejani's approach to bow rehair reflects the same attention to detail he brings to instrument repair. The choice of hair quality, the even distribution of hair across the bow stick, and the correct tensioning all affect the bow's playing characteristics after the rehair. A poorly executed rehair can actually make a bow worse than it was before; a skilled rehair can transform a bow's performance. For players who have not had their bow rehaired recently, LVL's workshop is the appropriate place to bring it for assessment.
