What customers usually need first

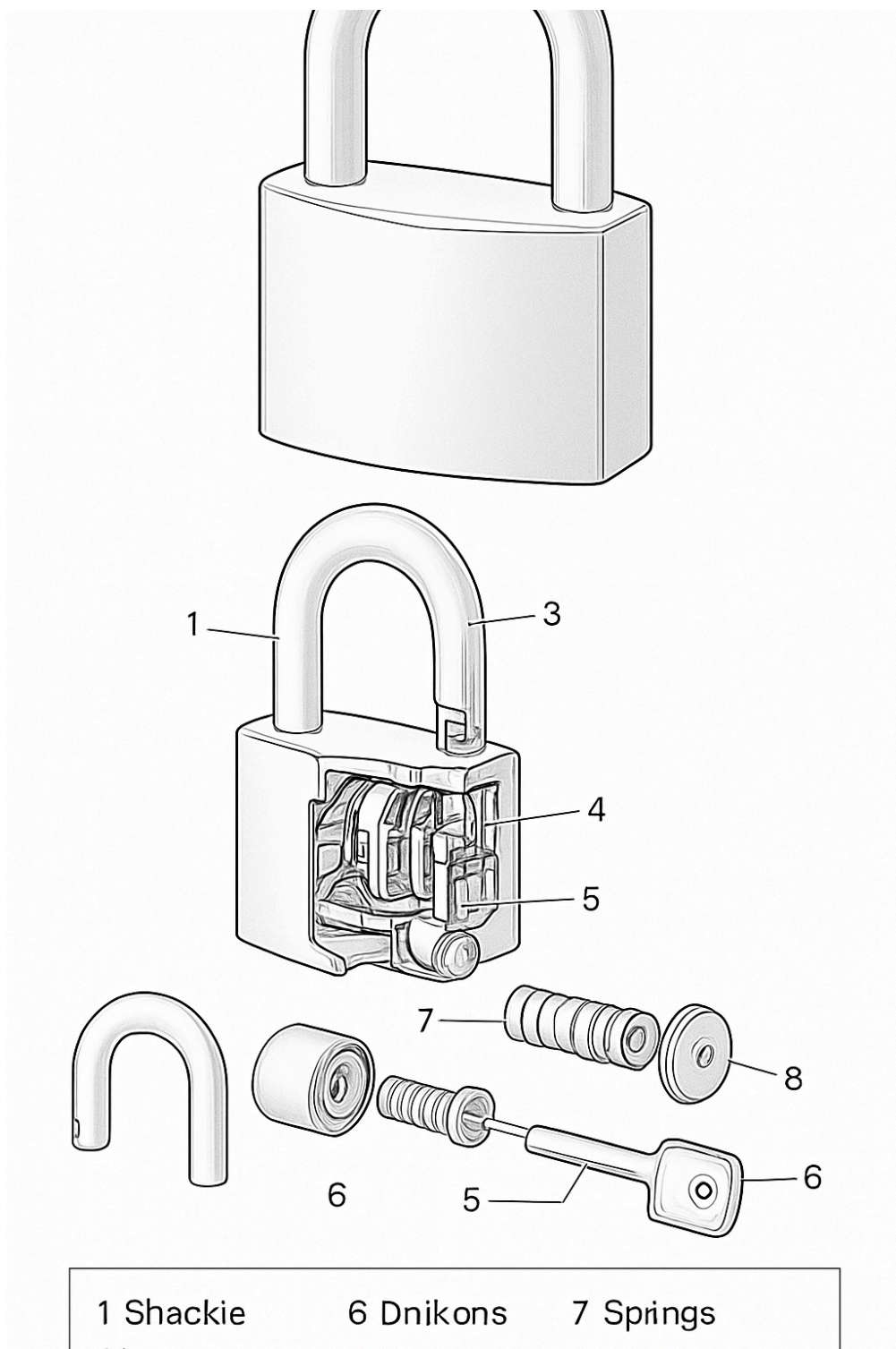
