

A home garage door is one of the largest moving systems in a Los Angeles home. It safeguards vehicles and belongings, influences curb appeal, and may be used multiple times daily. Because the door is heavy and depends on tightly wound springs, cables, tracks, rollers, and an opener, a slight malfunction can quickly become a security or entry concern.

Garage door repair in Los Angeles should open with a detailed assessment rather than a hasty component swap. Do not continue operating a door that is crooked, partially detached, or making grinding or snapping sounds. A professional safety inspection can identify hazards before the door falls or causes additional damage.

Why will an overhead garage door not open or shut?

If the garage door will not open, first check whether the opener has power and whether the wall control or remote has functioning batteries. A tripped breaker, disconnected motor, broken garage door opener gear, or failed circuit board can prevent operation. If the motor runs but the door does not move, the trolley, drive system, or connecting hardware may be damaged.

If the garage door will not close, inspect the photo-eye sensors near the floor on each side of the opening. They must face one another and remain free of dust, spider webs, stored items, and direct interference. Misaligned photo-eye sensors commonly cause a door to reverse immediately after touching the close button.

Garage door tracks can also stop normal operation. A bent garage door track, loose mounting bracket, or obstruction may cause the door to bind. Do not attempt to straighten a heavily damaged track while the door is under tension. A Los Angeles garage door technician can determine whether track adjustment, roller replacement, cable service, or garage door opener repair is recommended.

Is a broken garage door spring dangerous?

Yes. A damaged garage door spring can be hazardous because the spring stores significant energy and supports the door's weight. A torsion spring is installed above the door, while an extension spring is typically placed along the horizontal tracks. Both types can cause severe injury if removed, adjusted, or installed incorrectly.

Signs of a broken spring include a visible gap in the coil, a door that feels unusually heavy, a door that lifts only a few inches, loose cables, or a loud bang that happened while the door was closed. Do not stand beneath a partially supported door, pull on loose cables, or attempt a self-performed garage door spring replacement with household tools.

Professional garage door safety includes stabilizing the door, identifying the right spring specifications, checking the drums and cables, and testing balance after installation. Replacing only one spring on a paired system may not be advisable if the other spring is also worn. Ask the technician to clarify the repair and confirm that the completed door receives a balance and reversing-force test.
