- **Neighborhood Giveaways:** Many trusted material developers, banners, and esports companies host routine giveaways. These frequently require absolutely nothing more than following a social networks account or joining a Discord server.

- **Trading Up Low-Tier Skins:** Players can start with totally free weapon drops from random drops, sell them on the Steam Community Market, and use the wallet funds to purchase specific cases.

- A lot of these websites need logging in through Steam, which can expose accounts to phishing rip-offs or API frauds.
- Platforms that ask users to deposit funds or items simply to unlock a "totally free" case are generally predatory.
- Valve actively cracks down on betting and unapproved trading bots, implying users run the risk of having their Steam stocks trade-banned.

Stick strictly to main Valve drop systems and the main Steam Community Market to keep accounts totally protected.

1. Do I require CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to secure free cases?

Yes. To be qualified for weekly case drops and item drops, your Steam account must have Prime Status. Non-prime accounts do not receive random item drops or profile XP benefits that activate the weekly care package.
