Understanding Prohibited Items in Your Dumpster

Common Prohibited Items Include:

- Hazardous waste (e.g., chemicals, paints, pesticides, asbestos)
- Electronics (e-waste like computers, TVs)
- Refrigerants (e.g., from refrigerators, air conditioners)
- Flammable or explosive materials
- Medical waste
- Large amounts of concrete, bricks, or dirt (depending on the dumpster size and company policies)

Picking the wrong size often leads to overfilling or multiple rentals which increase costs. If you're unsure about your project scope, ask your dumpster provider. Local companies in Chesapeake are familiar with regional project types and waste volumes.

Weight Limits and Overage Cost Explained

Every dumpster has a maximum allowed weight, usually between 2 to 4 tons. These limits exist because weight influences the landfill tipping fee the company must pay. Going over the limit leads to an **extra charge** based on weight overage.

For example, if you rent a 20-yard dumpster with a 3,000 lbs weight limit and bring in 4,000 lbs of debris, you could be charged for the extra 1,000 lbs at around \$50 to \$100 or more.

Paying attention to weight is especially important in projects with heavy materials like:



- Concrete
- Roof shingles
- Dirt and sod

Avoid surprises by spreading the weight or renting a larger dumpster where appropriate.
