An office tower sought after polished stainless dimensional letters on a pitcher curtain wall. Under vibrant sunlight, the reflections broke the observe into shards. We additional a narrow, non-reflective charcoal backer panel in the back of the letters, set two inches off the glass. The letters nevertheless felt premium, but now the eye had a continuous luminance box. Tenants stopped giving guidance that incorporated "it is easy to miss us the 1st time."

A shop insisted on pink letters over a mid-tone eco-friendly fascia to suit a holiday marketing campaign. Red on efficient compresses evaluation for many visitors. We awarded two mockups at scale, one with red face lit letters over a deeper inexperienced panel, and one with white letters and a purple accessory bar. The workforce selected the white letters. Seasonal accents lived on customized banners and window vinyl, although the storefront signs and symptoms kept their all-season legibility. The numbers supported the option.
