Symptoms can include exhausting beginning, difficult going for walks, or intermittent pressure loss after the engine has been running for a brief time. In some situations, it clears when you heat matters up. That "works after heat" trend is a clue that ice and condensation are in touch.

Second is moisture same blockage. Moisture can enter using customary breath, seals through the years, or imperfect repairs practices. 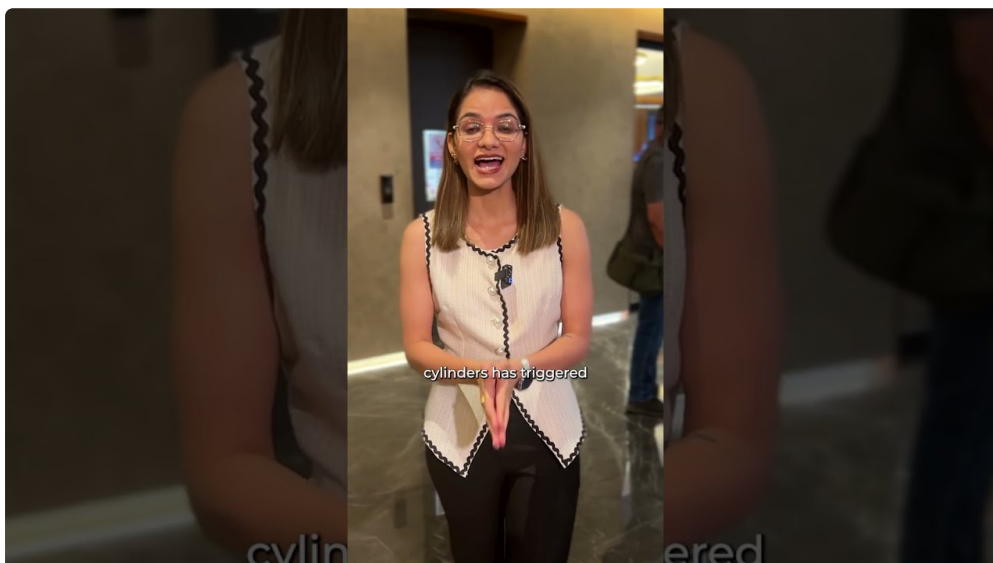
