Rake gently to arise flattened grass devoid of tearing crowns. Where vole runs snake throughout bluegrass, raking and a primary mow assuredly erase the tracks in per week.

Residential streets are calmer, yet driveway edges gather ice melt and sand. That sand smothers the strip in which turf already fights warmth from asphalt.
