Values are illustrative; the exact sequence differs by platform.

Betting Limits and Potential Payouts

Many online gambling establishments display minimum and maximum bet limits, which can be summed up as follows:

The **Return to Player (RTP)** for Mines typically falls between 94% and 96%, depending on the chosen mine count and any bonus includes used by the specific casino.
