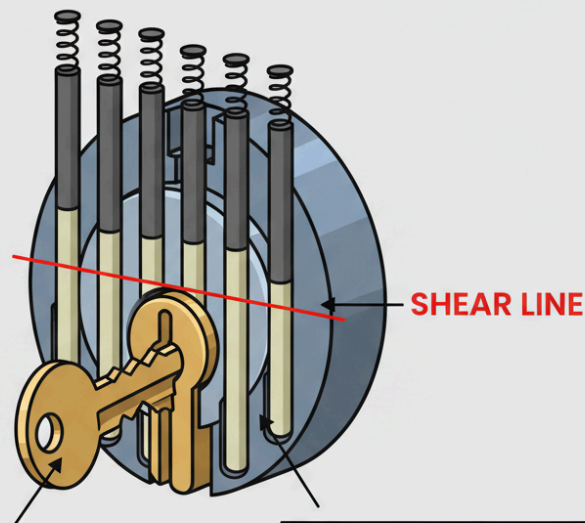
How to judge the quote
