Most Gretna lawns are blends of Kentucky bluegrass and tall fescue, with bluegrass dominating older streets around downtown and fescue gaining floor in more moderen subdivisions north of Highway 370. Those lawns look their premier with alternating forty five-diploma go angles and a two-week rotation of string trimming heights to evade ringing the bottom of older timber. Larger parcels on acreage west of 216th, specifically the ones catching Platte River breezes, name for wider deck mowers and a double cleanup cross when cottonwood fluff is flying. - Late March to mid May: 2.5 to 3.0 inches, deck freshly sharpened every 12 to fifteen provider hours, bag merely right through heavy spring flush.
- Late May through June: 3.0 to 3.25 inches, trade striping angles weekly to stop grain, trim carefully round new sod seams.
- July and August: 3.25 to 3.75 inches, bypass a equal-day cut after an afternoon downpour to offer protection to the crown, mulch clippings to conserve moisture.
- September: 3.0 to a few.25 inches, practice for aeration and overseeding, particularly in sunny front lawns close to concrete that radiated warm all summer season.
- October into early November: 2.5 to 2.75 inches for the very last two cuts, clear leaves to curb snow mould hazard along shaded fences.

We do no longer treat those as rigid principles. North-facing yards close to institution campuses behave in a different way than exposed corners by Nebraska Crossing in which wind strips moisture. The point is a method, not a fable.
