

A cracked windshield feels like a nuisance until you remember what that piece of glass is asked to do. It keeps wind, rain, and road debris out of the cabin, but it also plays a safety role in a crash. In many vehicles, the windshield helps manage occupant protection, supports passenger airbag deployment, resists intrusion, and contributes to roof support in a rollover.
