1. Galvanized steel, the dependable backbone

If you asked me for one door that examines the most boxes for most homes, I would guide you to shielded, galvanized steel. Steel doors have actually come far from the drab white boxes of the past. Today's panels lug deep embossing, realistic woodgrains, and manufacturing facility finishes that brush off scratches.

What issues first is density and finish. Panel density is commonly described by scale. Lower numbers mean thicker steel. For residential doors, you will certainly see 25 gauge on entry-level products, 24 scale as mid-grade, and 27 scale on some spending plan lines. In areas with road salt or regular dampness, a G90 door with a baked-on polyester or better yet a multi-layer paint system holds up years longer.

For energy, foam-in-place polyurethane insulation executes best, loading the panel and bonding to both skins. Seek R-values in the 10 to 18 variety for usual two-inch to three-inch thick areas. Polystyrene board insulation is fine for detached garages where you care less about temperature and noise.

Why do steel doors last? The frame is steady, areas are well engineered, and parts are widely available. Hinges, struts, rollers, and seals can be serviced as they use.
