In a downtown loft with concrete floors and steel home windows, the owners sought after the kitchen to act like part of the residing edge. We used a thin porcelain slab with a soft limestone print, mitered to study as a two-inch aspect. The backsplash ran full peak, retailers moved to the bottom of the top cabinets, and the island had no overhang at the window facet, so it examine like a monolith in place of a bar. When you sat at the sofa, the counters contemplated simply enough faded to lift the room devoid of pulling center of attention from the art wall.

A own family domestic with three faculty-age children and a severe cook wanted longevity especially. Perimeter counters went to leathered black granite. The island become Taj Mahal quartzite in a honed finish, which paired with white oak cabinets and helped bridge the warm-cool hole among the residing room rug and the stainless differ. We planned seam placement after templating, aligning the faint quartzite veins with the cupboard rails. Three years later, the surfaces nonetheless glance contemporary, and the occasional nick at the granite area buffs out with a diamond pad.

Budget, fee, and the place to spend
