Understanding the Betting Layout

The Crazy Time wheel is divided into 54 sections. Gamers can bet on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on among the 4 interactive reward video games. Each section has a different frequency on the wheel, straight affecting its payment capacity and likelihood of landing.
