- If you nick an edge, do now not chase it rainy, permit it dry, then straighten with a 1-inch contact-up brush

On cabinet cubbies or built-in bookshelves, get rid of adjustable cabinets and label each one pin hole row ahead of painting. If shelf bottoms would be visual, roll them off-site or on trestles for a cleaner end, then reinstall. Small details like this store the accent subject feeling intentional, now not hurried.

Sequencing that saves time

We coordinated timing with the signal installer so paint cured thoroughly in the past adhesive mounting. That avoided marred surfaces and gave the model punch devoid of overwhelming the distance.

A condominium unit upgrade had a narrow dining nook with chair rubs and scuffs. Instead of a tender matte accessory that could be tough to continue, we used a scrub-rated satin, tinted to a hot clay tone, and implemented a third skinny coat to even out stipple.
