

What Does Home Depot's \$99 Garage Door Opener Installation Cover?

Home Depot may promote a discounted labor price for garage door opener installation, but homeowners should understand what that price actually covers before arranging service. The \$99 figure generally refers to routine installation labor for a compatible garage door opener purchased through Home Depot, rather than the total cost of every part, adjustment, repair, or upgrade required at the property.

A standard appointment may involve installing the garage door opener, connecting the rail and motor unit, attaching the opener to the overhead garage door, programming remotes, and testing the automatic garage door.
