- **Frequency:** 1 section on the wheel.
- **How it works:** The supreme perk round. Players are transferred behind a giant red door into a vibrant, virtual world featuring a massive 64-segment wheel. The gamer needs to pick one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper indicate is granted.
